

Just a reminder to be cognizant of your pace of play. In order to make this game of golf fun, here are a few tips.

- **You don't have to rush to play, just be READY to play as soon as it is your turn. You can walk to your ball from a cart while another person is hitting if you don't distract them or walk in front of them.**
- **Take a few clubs with you so you don't have to walk back to your cart.**
- **When playing on or near the putting green, leave your bags or carts in such a position as will enable quick movement off the green and towards the next tee.**
- **Always record scores for the hole on the next tee, not the green of the hole you just played. That way someone can be teeing off while the scorekeeper does her job.**
- **When on the putting green, think about your putt BEFORE it is your turn to putt. Looking at it while walking up to mark it is a great idea.**
- **If someone is looking for their ball, buying beverages from the beverage cart, or in any other way not ready, go ahead and hit your ball.**
- **It is a group's responsibility to keep up with the group in front. If it loses a clear hole and is delaying the group behind, it should invite the group behind to play through, irrespective of the number of players in that group. Don't relax if you don't see the group behind you, it's not them you are worried about it's the group in FRONT of you that you need to keep up with.**
